### **Boats**

Stable crew boats, sculling recommended.

Crews should equip themselves with canoe paddles to assist with going through locks. Seats in coxed quads may be offered for hire to individual participants without their own boat by clubs with spare capacity.

### Cost

- 3 nights' accommodation (Thursday, Friday, Saturday) with full English breakfast
- dinners on Thursday, Friday and Saturday evening
- lunches on Friday, Saturday and Sunday
- transport to and from boating sites
- tour polo shirt
